GENERAL INFORMATION

Introduction

The 40th Annual Canadian Mineral Analysts (CMA) Conference and Exhibit, hosted by the Xstrata Zinc – Brunswick Smelter, co-hosted by the Community College of New Brunswick, CCNB campus of Bathurst, will be held at the Danny's Inn Restaurant & Conference Center, in Bathurst New Brunswick, Canada on September 15, 16, 17 and 18th, 2008. The Conference will feature technical presentations, workshops, an exhibit/trade show, and tours at Xstrata Zinc- Brunswick Mine and Xstrata Zinc- Brunswick Smelter.

The CMA Conference and Exhibit is held annually to provide an opportunity for analysts, technical staff and managers employed in analytical laboratories to exchange ideas and technical expertise, and to develop lasting and meaningful contacts, with their colleagues in the mining industry, and with manufacturers and suppliers of analytical equipment and related products and services.

Proceeds from the conference are used by the Canadian Mineral Analysts (CMA) to fund scholarships for students in chemical or environmental science programs at Canadian colleges and universities.

Two half day workshop have been scheduled for the 2008 CMA Conference and Exhibit. A workshop about statistical quality control, control charting and second one on sample preparation, troubleshooting for fusion preparation. Course content will be published as part of the Workshop Registration Package. Participants are requested to complete the "Workshop Registration" form. The workshop is available to participants who are not attending the 2008 CMA Conference and Exhibit.

Trade Show and Exhibits
